- **373** grants awarded to local and national charities totalling **£6,637,013**
- **2,883** individuals helped through grants totalling **£14,330,545**
- **£6,420,000** in support provided for residential care



LOCAL COMMUNITY SUPPORT

£172,060 given to charities in Hampshire and Isle of Wight

- **£15,000** for children aged up to five affected by poverty and neglect
- **£72,000** for children affected by domestic abuse
- **£15,060** for children with special educational needs and disabilities
- **£60,000** for improving the health and wellbeing of older people with dementia and their carers
- **£10,000** for other charitable causes
