This year, the MCF, the Freemasons' charity, grant helped fund the Onside program, which runs a 12-week course designed to support young people facing challenges like poor behavior, school exclusions, or being at risk of getting involved in crime. The programme uses sport as a tool to help boost confidence, self-esteem, and resilience in a fun and engaging way. Each young person gets a tailored experience, with one-to-one sessions that focus on their personal interests and needs. Ultimately, using the MCF grant, Onside successfully achieved its aims to help young people grow and thrive, giving them the tools to make better choices, build stronger relationships, and feel more confident in themselves and their future."
