During the past year, we have been able to open the Baby Equipment Loan Service and Toy Library four days each week so families can access the baby and safety equipment and can visit the Toy Library. We have also facilitated weekly Toddler Groups and one-off sessions, as well as spending time networking to ensure that families across North Tyneside are aware of the services we offer."
