### TOTAL SUPPORT

**£27,387,558**

overall support provided

- **373** grants awarded to local and national charities totalling **£6,637,013**
- **2,883** individuals helped through grants totalling **£14,330,545**
- **£6,420,000** in support provided for residential care



### LOCAL COMMUNITY SUPPORT

**£259,971** given to charities in Sussex

- **£75,000** for children aged up to five affected by poverty and neglect
- **£120,000** for children with special educational needs and disabilities
- **£7,500** for improving the health and wellbeing of older people with dementia and their carers
- **£37,471** given through Hospice UK grants in your Province
- **£20,000** for other charitable causes
